

HOLIDAYS IN FRANCE: In the heart of The Lot with Marian & Brain Clarke. Chambres D'Hôtes & Gîte

Under 2 hours from Toulouse airport, and 1½ from Rodez airport (a Ryanair destination) :
A beautiful location in the heart of the 'Parc Naturel Régional des Causses du Quercy' - by a quiet little village midway between Cahors and Figeac - 30 minutes away from the A20 motorway, or Assier rail station - near well known sites like St Cirq Lapopie - with GR 651 above, and Célé river valley below.
A listed ensemble of character: 3 well restored stone buildings with fine views down over trees to the river Célé, plus Château de Géniez, all set against an impressive backdrop of limestone cliffs (which are the southern edge of the plateau of Gramat - and an hour south of Rocamadour).



Rich in wildlife, the locality displays many varieties of Spring flowers and wild orchids, of butterflies and moths, with bird life from raptors to wrens - including a breeding pair of Eagle Owls in the local cliffs - plus good chances of spotting deer or wild boar. It officially has the darkest night sky in France.
Accommodation offered is: B & B in two en-suite rooms each with their own entrance, or self-catering in what was a typical modest Quercy barn and is now a 3-star Gîte well-equipped for 4 people (max 6). In the terraced garden is a 10m x 5m swimming pool with solar shower - and views !
